

**If you have determined the Challenge is a good fit for your classroom, organization, or group, here is what you need to know to get started quickly.**

### 1. REGISTER YOUR TEAM

Registration is simple, free, and only takes a minute. This step also puts you on the **map**—literally! Once you're registered we'll add your team to our interactive map within 72 hours. Registration also gives us helpful information about your team. **Register your team, here!**

### 2. CHOOSE YOUR LEARNING RESOURCES

Students Rebuild allows you to customize the way your team participates in our Challenges. Whether you have one hour or a whole school year, you can build your engagement to meet your team's needs. ### 5. SUBMIT ARTWORK TO STUDENTS REBUILD

There are two ways to submit your art to Students Rebuild—by mailing us your art pieces or digitally submitting them via email. Whichever you choose, the first step is to go to **[www.studentsrebuild.org/submit](http://www.studentsrebuild.org/submit)**. Once there, you'll be able to enter your team's final numbers to process your submission. This gives us key information and creates your printable mailing slip to include in your package or allows you to email us photos of your art.
